

#### 2014 Annual Event

The Community Foundation held its 3rd Annual Event on January 24, 2014 with Jeff Yost as keynote speaker. Mr. Yost, President/CEO for the Nebraska Community Foundation spoke to attendees about how the Community Foundation can serve as the best means to promote charitable giving in Northwest Missouri and ensure money remains here to benefit residents.

Philanthropy can become an effective tool to fund community development projects and help erase a crisis of confidence in rural communities. "This is not about the money," Mr. Yost said. "We are awash in capital in the Midwest", he said. "Money is a tool to change the outcomes we have."

His foundation's mission is to help communities help themselves. He said it's up to a

communities residents to decide what works best for them in terms of development opportunities and gave examples of how his region has been successful.

Intergenerational transfer of wealth is proving to be integral to fostering success stories in Nebraska, according to Mr. Yost. A strategy like this builds community philanthropy and endowments. It's up to the
