

JC Warren Scholarship Fund

Purpose: This fund was established in honor of Doris and J.C. Warren, who have been a part of the Lafayette/Northend family for over 40 years to provide academic scholarships to a graduating senior of Lafayette High School.

Mrs. Doris Warren, the former Counseling Center secretary, graduated from Lafayette in 1957 and worked at LHS from 1997 until her retirement in 1999. Her late husband, J.C., lost his battle with cancer in August 1998. Even though J.C. attended and graduated from another high school in Kansas, he was devoted to Lafayette and was actually voted an “honorary” member of the 1957-1958 classes at a class reunion. Doris and J.C. have two daughters, Jill Walker and Jean Warren, who also graduated from Lafayette in 1981 and 1984.

Both Doris and J.C. loved the northend, they loved teenagers, and most of all, they loved Lafayette. This scholarship is their way of expressing how they feel about Lafayette and their way of saying thank you for all the good times and great memories of the “Fighting Irish” and the “Big Green School”.

Criteria: In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:

The students eligible shall be a graduating senior of Lafayette High School who has strong Northend ties planning to continue their education through a two or four year college/university or technical school.

The scholarship is selected by a committee composed of the guidance counselors at Lafayette High School and Doris’ daughter Jean Warren.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and disbursed in August.

Amount: No less than \$100 depending on available funds.

Deadline: March 1
