friends to provide academic scholarships to seniors of Central High

Criteria: In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:

The students eligible for assistance shall be graduating seniors who participated in cross country or track for four years and maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Consideration will be given to the student's athletic achievements, academic performance, citizenship and future goals.

Submit a scholarship application on a form provided by the Foundation.

Include a one page essay on what participating in long distance running has meant to the student as well as their future goals and ambitions.

Include 2 reference letters.

Guidelines: Student must continue to attend classes, be enrolled in a minimum of 12

credit hours per semester and keep a 3.0 grade point average (or

equivalent).

Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in equal

payments in August and January.

Amount: Minimum of \$1,000 annually to be paid in two equal installments for up to

four years. The second installment will be released upon proof of good

academic progress (transcript required as proof) and enrollment.

Deadline: June 1.
