

Kadyn McClellan Memorial Scholarship Fund

Purpose: This fund was established in memory of Kadyn McClellan by his family to provide academic scholarships to graduating seniors of Trenton, Chillicothe and Albany High Schools.

Criteria: In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:

The students eligible for assistance shall be graduating seniors of Trenton, Chillicothe or Albany High Schools pursuing a degree in Allied Health or Agriculture.

Student must have a 2.5 grade point average or higher (or equivalent).

Submit a scholarship application on a form provided by the Foundation.

Submit an essay indicating why the student desires a vocation in the related field and what a college education means to them. Essay must be no more than 1000 words.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in equal payments in August and January.

Amount: Two awards – one in Allied Health and one in Agriculture. A minimum of \$500 with the option by the committee to offer an additional award, depending on the quality of applicants or two awards of \$750 each. Planned total award will be \$1,500. The award will be released upon proof of enrollment from the College/University.

Deadline: March 1
