

Livingston County First Responders Scholarship Fund

- Purpose:** This fund was established to provide academic scholarships to persons who wish to serve as first responders for an agency located within Livingston County, MO.
- Criteria:** In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:
- The applicant must be entering the profession of fire fighter, first responder, emergency medical technician, paramedic, police officer or sheriff deputy.
- The applicant must be a resident of Livingston County, MO or plan to become a resident of Livingston County, MO after completion of training.
- The applicant must commit the first three years of their service after graduation to a Livingston County, MO first responder agency.
- The applicant must be able to pass a drug screening test.
- Police officer and sheriff deputy applicants may attend a law enforcement academy of their choice. The law enforcement academy should be acceptable and approved by the committee prior to enrollment.
- Firefighter, emergency medical technician and paramedic applicants must receive their training through Grand River Technical School in Chillicothe, MO.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in equal payments in August and January.
- Amount:** \$1,000 to \$5,000
- Deadline:** Applications are accepted year round.
