- 5. Special consideration will be given to students who have not received a significant amount of financial aid and/or scholarship money. Please attach a copy of your financial aid award letter to this application (if you submit the FAFSA by March 1st, you will receive the financial aid award letter from your University by April 15th).
- 6. Select <u>one</u> of the following questions and respond in 200 words or less.
 - A. How has your education at Central High School prepared you for the next step of your life?
 - B. Has one teacher or class been of particular value to you and your education?
 - C. What have you gained from your education at Central High School?
- 7. This scholarship will be awarded at the annual Scholarship Night, held in the spring at Central High School.
