

Jerry and Sandra Mogg Scholarship Fund

Purpose: This fund was established by Jerry and Sandra Mogg to provide academic scholarships to students from developing countries.

Criteria: In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:

Tier 1

The student must be a student from a developing country with preference given to Honduran students, attending Graceland University in Lamoni, IA.

Student must be a member of The Community of Christ denomination.

Tier 2

Past recipients of this scholarship who are furthering their education at any school as an under-graduate or graduate student.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed at the beginning of the Fall and Spring semesters.

Once the student has been selected, they will continue to have precedence over others who apply, according to funds available. The student is required to be making timely progress on their education in accordance with the Director of International Programs at Graceland University. The student must submit a letter from the Director of International Programs and a billing statement from the University showing all grants, discounts and scholarships received, and the amount owed by the student.

Amount: Total cost to attend Graceland University after other grants, discounts and scholarships to be received. Payments will be paid twice a year, at the beginning of each semester for up to five years. Each installment will be released upon receipt of a completed verification form required or verification of enrollment for past recipients receiving further aid.
