

David Grimsley Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Purpose:** This fund was established in honor of David Grimsley, who taught in the social studies department while at Central High School. His career as a caring teacher and coach ended abruptly with his death from leukemia in 1974. This scholarship recognizes seniors who exemplify the qualities of David Grimsley himself: Good citizenship, interest in social studies and athletics.
- Criteria:** In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:
- The students eligible shall be a graduating senior of Central High School who is planning to pursue a career in social studies or a related field (geography, history, political science or social studies).
- The student must exemplify the qualities of good citizenship, has an interest in social studies and in sports.
- The student must have a 2.5 (or higher) GPA in social studies.
- The scholarship is dependent on the student's financial need.
- The scholarship is selected by five teachers, at least two of which are in the Social Studies department and Mrs. Lynette Barr.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and disbursed in August.
- Amount:** \$150
- Deadline:** March 1
